Find the expressions expressions Lynn uses to talk about :

- **Drawbacks (-)**

the A51 **lacks optical image** stabilization

the phone is **not without its faults**

- **Advantages (+)**

with the A51 you just have **more options**

the iPhone is **much better at recording** video and its colors are **more true to life**

packs a lot of excellent hardware

- **Identical performances (=)**

the new iPhone SE which has only one rear camera **takes comparable photos as A51**

the phone clocked in about 16 hours on our battery drain test for continuous video playback on airplane mode

which is on par with the iPhone

all in all the galaxy A51 **sluggishness** is its biggest drawback
